Dear Dance Parents,

Thank you for supporting the St. Luke's Dance Program. It has been a delight to teach your children this semester and I look forward to an exciting and productive second semester. Second semester enrollment forms will be online before the Christmas break. The annual St. Luke's dance performance will be held at St. Luke's on Friday May 18, 2012. Please keep the week of May 14th free for extra rehearsals. A mandatory dress rehearsal will be from 4 - 6 p.m. on Wednesday May 16, 2012. The recital theme this year is Under the Sea and we are having a great time working on choreography patterns and viewing costume choices. The dance program has grown thanks to your support and I am anxious to showcase your talented children. It was/is my vision and passion to build a dance program at St. Luke's and I now have two wonderful teachers on dance faculty.

It is necessary to collect all costume fees by December 15th, so I can place my costume order in early January. The costume companies receive thousands of orders and fill them as they receive them. This letter accompanies your child's costume order form.

If your dancer takes more than one dance class per week, there will be a costume for each of those classes unless I have advised otherwise. For instance, if your child takes two PK dance classes she/he will have two different costumes and be in two onstage dances. If your child takes ballet, jazz, and tap there will be three different costumes and three different onstage dances. A recital fee is due per child.
