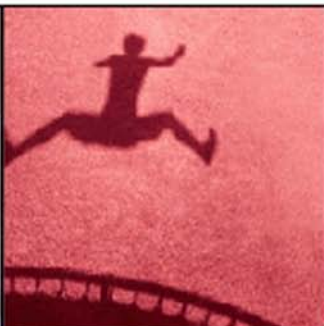

# Fencing at St. Luke's

**INTERMEDIATE LEVEL**

The sport of fencing is fun and dynamic. An athlete must possess physical skills of agility, endurance and speed combined with the mental toughness to think quickly and accurately in order to "outsmart" the opponent. General motor movement is developed while learning the basic fencing footwork and blade-work. Balance, agility and strength is also developed through fun sport-specific games and drills. Fencing is also considered an "honorable" sport and students will learn the importance of good sportsmanship and manners during a fencing match. Students should expect a fun yet challenging class in which basic techniques will be learned and then used in one-on-one fencing.

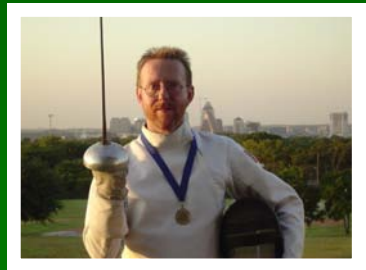

She continued her studies in Spain and the United States at Memphis University where she obtained her Masters in the Orff method of music education. "Miss Anita" founded Music Masters in San Antonio in 1982. The Music Masters' program includes the methods of Orff, Kodaly and Dalcroze, as well as technique and curriculum personally developed by Anita.

Music Masters is a child-centered, age appropriate program. The curriculum is very sequential and structured and it is designed to give children a solid foundation in music theory and piano/keyboard playing, while developing their musical skills: rhythm, listening and singing skills.

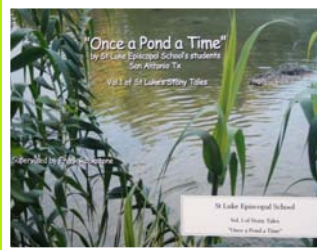

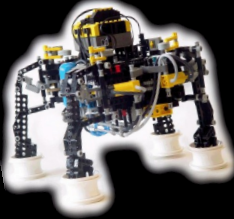

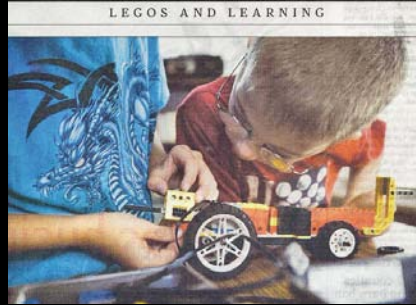
# American Robotics Academy

## Freshman Robotics (FR)

Students explore the use of motors, gears, pulleys, pneumatics, remote control and operation of the RCX (microprocessor robot brain). As a favorite class, students work in teams of two's or three's, collaborating with one another to prepare their robotic invention for class competition. The Terrible Toxins" Mission: Your mission is to clear an area that's loaded with dangerous toxic waste. Teamwork is necessary here to design a robot that can pick up the dangerous canisters and move them out.



One member of the team will remotely control the robot, while another works the pneumatic claw to pick up and deposit the toxins into the "safe zone".

# Martial Arts

**Tiny Tigers** - Developed by educators who were also martial artists and directed towards children under the age of four. Tiny Tigers program is a comprehensive program with emphasis on three foci: Basic martial arts skills, life skills and safety skills. The classes are directed towards completion of units in these three areas of study:

**Martial Arts** - The child learns basic stances, blocks, hand techniques, foot techniques, stretching and very simple practical application of these techniques. The purpose of learning these techniques is to develop motor control and self discipline. Typically, children who develop motor control will excel in other sports.

**Life Skills** - The child learns life skills which enhance his/her well being and development in the years to come. The units covered in the life skill focus on: Balance, cooperation, coordination, discipline, exercise, listening, nutrition and respect.

**Safety Skills** - The child learns safety skills which help to lead to a safer life. Units covered include: Fire, stranger awareness, traffic, health, holiday safety, weather and first aid.

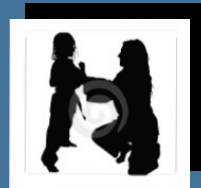

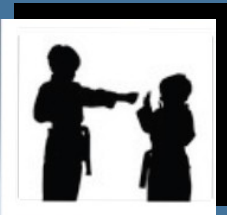
