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TEACHER/STUDENT INTERACTION

- Immediate teacher access during the school day
- Delayed teacher access during the school day
- Potential need for supervised oversight at home during the school day

COURSES AND INSTRUCTION

- Student must be engaged daily in all coursework
- Student predominantly receives instruction and directions in “real-time” from teacher
- Student predominantly receives instruction and directions “remotely” from teacher
- All core classes available
- Limited specials/elective courses available

INSTRUCTION

- Consistently scheduled access to teacher
- Daily teacher contact/communications
- Potential for a more flexible daily schedule
- Daily course engagement required
- Clear, concise directions on accessing instruction
- Access to appropriate instructional materials

ASSESSMENT

- Student progress measured by regular assessments
- Parent access to grades
- Consistent grading practices (numerical/letter grades)
