



## **Holt Family Endowed Scholarship Application**

The Holt Family Endowed Scholarship is a \$10,000 scholarship awarded to two students entering 5th through 8th grade. The student may be new to St. Luke's for the upcoming academic year, or a returning St. Luke's student.

The scholarship shall be awarded for one academic year. A student who has received the Holt Family Endowed Scholarship and who otherwise meets the eligibility criteria may apply for subsequent academic years. Scholarship recipients are expected to embody the pillars of Scholarship, Citizenship, and Leadership at St. Luke's by maintaining a high academic average, participating in extracurricular activities, and demonstrating excellent character both inside and outside the classroom.

Please carefully review and adhere to the following requirements and deadlines.

### **Holt Family Endowed Scholarship Criteria**

- Be a newly admitted or returning SLES student for the upcoming school year, entering grades 5-8.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Demonstrates good character and the ability to make a positive contribution to the SLES community.
- Grade average of 85 or above.

### **Scholarship Application Requirements**

- Holt Family Endowed Scholarship Form
- Required Scholarship Essays
- For new students:
  - A completed SLES application, including all supplemental documents/requirements
- For returning students:
  - A letter of recommendation from a community leader or someone who knows the student well (not a relative). Letters should be emailed to Zandra Cook, Director of Enrollment Management at [zcook@sles-sa.org](mailto:zcook@sles-sa.org) or dropped off in sealed envelope.

- Most recent report card will be pulled by the school

### **Selection Process**

- April 27, 2023 by 4:00 p.m. - Applications Due to St. Luke's Office of Admissions
- May 5, 2023 - Scholarship Finalists will be notified. Finalists will be asked to come to campus for an in-person interview on the evening of May 10, 2023. Interviews will last no more than 30 minutes each. You will sign up for a timeslot when you are notified that you have been chosen as a finalist.
- May 10, 2023 - Finalist Interviews beginning at 6:00 p.m.
- May 12, 2023 - Recipients will be notified.
